

"Students rarely, if ever, come back unchanged... They experience a global church and begin to see the gospel and the Church as much more than what happens in their local body on Sundays. They are humbled and, often, overwhelmed by the challenges that they are faced with over the course of the trip. Prayer becomes a more important resource to them. They often leave a part of themselves in South Africa and long to return. Some have gone back as interns for longer periods of time. Two are now full time mission partners and have dedicated their lives to serving among the amaZioni. Others speak of doing so after they retire.
